Chapter 2 God gives His Word: "Trust Me, I will deal with it in time, be faithful while you wait."

"I will climb up to my watchtower and stand at my guard post. There I will wait to see what the Lord says and how he will answer my complaint. ² Then the Lord said to me, "Write my answer plainly on tablets, so that a runner can carry the correct message to others. ³ This vision is for a future time. It describes the end, and it will be fulfilled. If it seems slow in coming, wait patiently, for it will surely take place. It will not be delayed. ⁴ "Look at the proud! They trust in themselves, and their lives are crooked. But the righteous will live by their faithfulness to God."

Key Bible Theme - Delay/Waiting

When we see evil and injustice, we naturally question God. God answers us with His Word: "Trust Me, I will deal with it in time, be faithful while you wait."

N.T. Wright, Surprised by Scripture

Our general responses to evil/wrong:

- We ignore the problem of evil until it hits us in the face (gets personal)
- We are surprised by evil/wrong when it does
- We react in immature and dangerous ways

Three introductory Biblical responses to evil/wrong:

- there are no easy answers, in Scripture or elsewhere

(if we think we have solved the problem of evil that just shows we haven't really understood it.)

- the line between good and evil does not lie between "us and them", it runs thru middle of all of us

- God will put the world right in Christ

We Practice Patience to Seek God's Word
