### **Twenty Third Psalm**

**Allegory** = figure of speech with abstract ideas described in terms of characters, figures and events.

In OT God is often portrayed as a Shepherd

Genesis 48:15 "...the God who has been my shepherd all my life, to this very day..."

Isaiah 40:11 "He will feed his flock like a shepherd. He will carry the lambs in his arms..."

Micah 7:14 "O LORD, protect your people with your shepherd's staff, lead your flock..."

The Lord is my shepherd;

I have all that I need.
